

Ojibway Club Covid-19 Protocols *subject to change*

Our general protocols for 2021 are similar to our previous season. Please reference the summary of the province of Ontario reopening Step 1 restriction that are presently in effect till July 2nd. This document will be refreshed following the next Government announcement, if the progression of the guidelines are met to move to Step 2.

We ask that when visiting our facilities, follow the government mandatory protocols to keep all members, staff and visitors safe and healthy. Please take personal responsibility to protect yourself and others at all times and exercise physical distancing.

General

- ✓ Always demonstrate physical distancing of 2m/6 feet
- ✓ Read all protocol signage on main dock on the information board prior to using tennis courts or walking trail (Club access to the island 7am-5 pm daily)
- ✓ Facility access is not permitted for any members and staff in quarantine/self isolation or experiencing symptoms of covid-19
- ✓ Do not come to the club if you are sick or feeling unwell or have been exposed to someone who has systems or tested positive for covid-19 (use our pre-screen test on our website home page and follow directions)
- ✓ Hand wash station available in front of arts and craft hut and in our washroom facilities. Please wash your hands routinely during your visit to the Island
- ✓ We encourage you to bring your own hand sanitizer and drinking water as no fountains available
- ✓ Use proper sneezing/coughing technique by using inner elbow
- ✓ Please **no** handshakes or high fives
- ✓ Please ensure garbage is taken with you or disposed of properly (in bins adjacent to path by grocery store) for the safety of our staff

Docking

- ✓ Parking provided on the unless posted as a designated boat slip or marked for activity or dockside pick-up for grocery & gift or snack bar take-out Ojibway Club hotel/office
- ✓ The hotel/office will be open Virtual, by phone or in person
- ✓ The office can be contacted by phone or email if you have inquiries or wish to book a tennis court and don't have access to our GameTime online booking software
- ✓ Snack bar take-out service will be provided and delivered to your boat by calling our direct line
- ✓ All public washrooms available on Island with Hotel, Tennis Hut and Movie Hut
- ✓ Tennis courts must be booked in advance through GameTime or by phone. No walk-on play permitted. Please reference the tennis protocol appendix.
- ✓ Tennis court gates, tennis hut and washrooms will be locked outside of our access hours of operation (at discretion of tennis pro)
- ✓ Access to tennis court outside of listed operating hours is at the discretion of the tennis pro
- ✓ Guest access to courts must be booked by a member through GameTime

✓ Tournaments, clinics and round robins have been modified to meet the mandated protocols for Step 1 reopening of the Province of Ontario – Reevaluation will be considered after Government announcement on July 2nd

Club Events

✓ are restricted/limited in numbers and only outdoors during the Step 1 reopening of the Province of Ontario - physical distance protocols and mandatory gathering sizes will be reevaluated on July 2nd following the next Provincial announcement.

✓ Social events ie: Ojibway AGM will take place outside and expedited to an hour if possible. Details to follow.

Staff and facility

✓ All staff will be provided with PPE equipment (mandatory mask and eyewear when applicable plus have their own designated hand washing stations and staff washroom facilities

✓ Protocols are in place to ensure staff adhere to physical distancing guidelines and symptom monitoring is done daily through our new online pre-screening program (see our website home page for the link

✓ Hand sanitizer will be provided at stores for staff and members

✓ **Mask are mandatory to be worn when inside any building including Hotel, Arts & Crafts, Movie Hut, Tennis Hut, Grocery & Gift Store or at times outside when Physical Distancing is compromised**

✓ If you arrive without your own personal mask and wish to enter one of our buildings or retail outlets the Club has made it convenient to purchase a mask through:

✓ Grocery Store Grab & Go window

✓ Gift Store dockside coffee/ice cream window

✓ Snack Bar sign in station/counter

✓ Office window

✓ Mask are available for a nominal fee of \$1 if required.

✓ Washrooms and high touch areas will be sanitized and disinfected by our staff routinely throughout the day

✓ Limited number of people in stores during Step 1 of the reopening of the Province of Ontario which at present permits **(8) eight customers in Grocery Store** and **(6) six customers in Gift Shop**. If visiting the Snack bar please sign in for customer tracing requirements by government health agencies and exercise 6 ft physical distancing when moving through the line or exiting

Seating is restricted to 4 or less per table, **please do not move tables** as they are positioned to accommodate the required 6 ft physical distancing requirements in Step 1 till Government review on July 2nd.

We expect all in this community to follow these protocols. As Dr. Bonnie Henry says, “let’s be kind, be calm and be safe”.
